

2024 AUTUMN GRADUATION

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Have I qualified and is my name on the graduation list?

You must fulfil all requirements to graduate for your diploma/degree. If you are uncertain, please check with your Faculty Office as the onus is on you to check that you have been marked on the system as qualified.

What about the name on my certificate and in the graduation booklet?

- Please ensure that your full name is correctly reflected on the system as on your birth certificate, ID document, or passport.
- If your name is reflected incorrectly on your DUT record, or you have subsequently changed your name (legally), please submit a copy of your ID document or passport to your Faculty to process the necessary amendments.
- This must be done at least 30 days before the ceremony date.
- Please consult your Faculty Office should there be a discrepancy in the details of your names.
- Your official name at the time of graduation will appear on your certificate.
- Your graduation certificate will not be re-issued due to errors in your names.

What should I wear to the graduation ceremony?

In keeping with the formal nature of our graduation ceremony, we would like to remind you that the dress code is formal or traditional. Additionally, in keeping with university traditions, you must wear the correct academic dress when attending your graduation ceremony. If you do not, you might not be admitted to the graduation hall.

Where do I get my gown and hood?

You may purchase or hire your academic attire from House of Graduates who are the official suppliers and they will provide the correct attire for your qualification. Please see the details below on how to order or purchase your academic attire.

Do I need a ticket for the ceremony?

- The graduate will be issued with one ticket.
- You may invite a maximum of three guests to attend the ceremony with you.
- We regret that no extra guests can be accommodated.
- The guest tickets will be available for collection at the demarcated area in the graduation venue, from 07:30 for the 09:00 ceremony, 12:30 for the 14:00 ceremony, and 16:30 for the 18:00 ceremony.
- Please note that no persons will be allowed access to the ceremony without a guest ticket.

Can I get additional tickets for the graduation ceremony?

We regret that no extra tickets can be issued. Please note that no persons will be allowed access to the ceremony without a ticket.

How long is the graduation ceremony?

We are unable to confirm the exact duration. You can expect the ceremony to be approximately two (2) hours in duration. Graduates and guests are requested to remain seated for the full duration of the ceremony. As a courtesy and respect for your fellow graduates, please do not leave the venue until the ceremony is concluded.

Are children permitted to attend the graduation ceremony?

- For the comfort and enjoyment of all attendees, please note that children under the age of 10 will not be permitted into the graduation venue.
- This approach is in place to ensure a focused and uninterrupted experience for all guests, as graduation ceremonies often involve speeches, presentations, and moments of significance that benefit from a quiet and respectful atmosphere.
- We kindly request that parents and guardians make necessary arrangements for the care of young children who fall under this age bracket.

Where do I take graduation photos?

- An accredited photographer and videographer have been appointed to take your official photographs on stage and record all graduation ceremonies.
- Your guests should refrain from taking their photographs and any recording during the ceremony.
- The accredited photographer and videographer will issue details to you on the day of your
 graduation for payment and collection. For the sake of family and friends who are unable to
 attend the event, we will also be live-streaming the ceremonies, check our website

Can I defer and choose to attend a later ceremony?

No. It is not possible to elect to defer your attendance to a future date. If you are not able to attend the graduation ceremony, you will graduate in absentia. No correspondence will be entered into regarding the deferment of graduation.

I did not attend the graduation ceremony. How can I get my certificate?

If you are unable to attend your ceremony, you may collect your degree/diploma/certificate by producing your <u>ID document</u> at your Faculty Office no later than one month after your graduation ceremony. Your driver's license will NOT be accepted when collecting certificates.

If you are unable to physically collect your certificate from DUT, you may arrange for the despatch of your certificate by courier services or registered mail based on your preferred method of despatch.

Please complete and submit the form entitled 'Request for the despatch of a Graduation Certificate' which is obtainable by clicking HERE (select your Faculty Folder and look for Form 26) and select one of the following options to receive your certificate (subject to all arrear fees being settled and outstanding documents being submitted)

For this option, you will need to:

DESPATCH BY COURIER SERVICES

Please note that when selecting despatch by courier services you will need to provide the courier services with a FULL PHYSICAL ADDRESS. The physical address cannot be a P O Box address. Failure to supply a full physical address will result in your certificate not being delivered.

DESPATCH BY REGISTERED MAIL

For this method of despatch, DUT will arrange to have your degree/diploma certificates posted to you by registered mail.

Please note that when selecting despatch by registered mail you will need to provide us with a FULL POSTAL ADDRESS.

A tracking number will be provided to you once the certificates have been despatched with a link to the South African Post Office Track and Trace webpage. In South Africa, you will not receive the documents at your physical address. Rather, your nearest Post Office will send you a notification to collect your documents from that branch.

COSTS TO DESPATCH CERTIFICATES

Should you elect to have your certificate couriered to you, you will be required to cover the delivery costs.

Please ensure that your address details on the student portal is updated with the most recent postal and physical address.

If the graduate is sending someone to collect their certificate on their behalf, they would need to comply with the following procedure:

- Please complete and submit the form entitled 'Authorisation of Release/Collection of Information By Third Party' which is obtainable by clicking HERE (select your Faculty Folder and look for Form 21) or alternatively contact your relevant Faculty Office to obtain a copy of the application. Complete the authorization form (obtainable from the Faculty Office).
- The bearer must produce an **original ID/passport document**. A driver's license will not be acceptable.
- The bearer must produce a certified copy of the graduate's ID/passport.
- The release of the certificate is subject to all arrear fees being settled and outstanding documents being submitted.

How will the University be communicating with me regarding graduation arrangements?

The university will communicate with you via email using ONLY your <u>official DUT4Life email</u> <u>address</u>. You are encouraged to check your <u>DUT4Life email address</u> regularly to ensure that you do not miss out on important communication from the University.

Will DUT arrange and pay for my graduation certificate to be dispatched?

Should you elect to have your certificate couriered to you, you will be required to cover the delivery costs.

Can I bring personal belongings into the graduation venue?

Due to security and space constraints, it is advised to bring only essential personal belongings to the graduation venue. Large bags, backpacks, and bulky items may not be permitted inside the venue. Please plan accordingly and consider leaving unnecessary items at home or in your vehicle

Will there be parking available at the graduation venue?

Yes, parking will be available.

- Midlands Parking: Sports Ground, Indumiso Campus and FET Parking
- Durban Parking: Olive Convention Centre Undercover Parking at a fee of R20 per session

Where are the graduation ceremonies being held?

Can I request special accommodations for guests with disabilities?

DUT is committed to ensuring that all guests can participate fully in the graduation ceremony. If you or any of your guests require special accommodations in terms of your disability, please contact the Disability Rights Unit at least 30 days before the ceremony date to make necessary arrangements.

Please note that if you do not indicate that you require assistance timeously, the Disability Rights Unit will be unable to prioritise your request for assistance on the day of the graduation ceremony as there are limited resources available.

Will there be refreshments available during the graduation ceremony?

Unfortunately, no refreshments will be provided at the ceremony. However, it's recommended to eat a meal beforehand as the ceremony duration is approximately 2 hours. You may bring water or a small snack which can be consumed **outside** the venue, especially if you have dietary restrictions or medical needs.

Can I request a specific seating arrangement for myself and my guests?

Seating arrangements for graduates are typically pre-assigned based on various factors, including faculty, degree and programmes However, guest seating is unreserved and guests may be seated on a first-come-first-served basis. Unfortunately, specific seating requests for guests may not be accommodated. Please note that seating assignments are subject to availability and final discretion by the event organizers.

Settle library and disciplinary matters before 31 March 2024

Ensure that you have a clear library record and owe no library fines or outstanding books. Ensure that you settle all pending disciplinary matters with the Student Disciplinary Tribunal. You will not receive your diploma/degree certificate at the 2024 Autumn graduation ceremony if you have unpaid disciplinary/library fines and outstanding library books.

Will the ceremony be livestreamed?

Yes. The graduation ceremony will be livestreamed from the DUT website www.dut.ac.za.

Can I attend the ceremony and receive my degree certificate if I have outstanding fees?

You may attend the graduation ceremony however your certificate will be withheld until you have settled your outstanding fees.

Is it possible to receive my degree certificate before the ceremony?

Unfortunately, it is not permitted to obtain your degree certificate prior to the official graduation ceremony where the qualification will be conferred. You may request a qualification confirmation letter from the relevant Faculty Office to serve as a temporary substitute until the ceremony.

If I owe the university fees, would I be allowed to obtain my graduation certificate?

No. All arrear fees owed to the university must be paid in full before the certificate will be issued to you. Please contact the Finance Department using the following details to make arrangements concerning payment of fees.
